Abstract

The Gulson Collection is a repository of materials relating to the history of The Gulson Brickworks, including the Wollondale Brewery, Gulson family history, and other Brickworks across Australia. It also contains information on operating brickwork equipment, original blueprints for Coke ovens, published and unpublished articles, and promotional material. The photo collection includes historical and contemporary photos relating to the businesses and family history. The Gulson family played an important role in the development of the Goulburn district, through their involvement in business and community organisations, and connection to many other prominent families of the district.

Scope and Content

The boxes have been divided into the areas of Gulson Brickwork's History; Family History; Ephemera; and Miscellaneous Brickworks. The photos have been divided into Brickwork's history; and Family History.

Conditions Governing Access and Use

The collection is available for research. Copying and publication of material is subject to Copyright restrictions. Access to the collection is by appointment with The Local Studies Officer.

Immediate Source of Acquisition

This collection was personally donated to Goulburn Mulwaree Library by Geoff Gulson in 2017. Portions of the business archives have previously been donated to The Noel Butlin Archives Centre, Australian National University. Correspondence relating to this is in The Gulson Collection.
